- A response was received from Chris Townley with an update on the parking restriction consultation for Elm Park Primary School. This has been sent to the member of the public who raised this at a previous council meeting.
- The updated grant and metal detecting policies, agreed at the previous meeting, have been published on the website.
- The Biodiversity Net Gain report has been completed. The outcome was a suggestion to plant two small trees at the Recreation Ground.
- Following the clearing of the recent fly tipping at the Frenchay Museum Car Park, which cost over £200, unfortunately more has appeared. The Clerk is working with Frenchay members to discuss preventative measures.

Cllr Watkins advised Frenchay Councillors are submitting a 'Highway Improvement Form', which is the correct route for raising issues with South Gloucestershire Council.
